**Ikusei Syogakukin** (Cultivation of students)

Willingness to study: Students must have a strong desire for learning, an positive attitude towards study and an average of grade 3 or above.

Income base line: 1.5 times more than basic Welfare support (livelihood protection)  
3 times of Welfare Standard (for earnest and active student)

Application: School offices (In Nara Prefecture)
