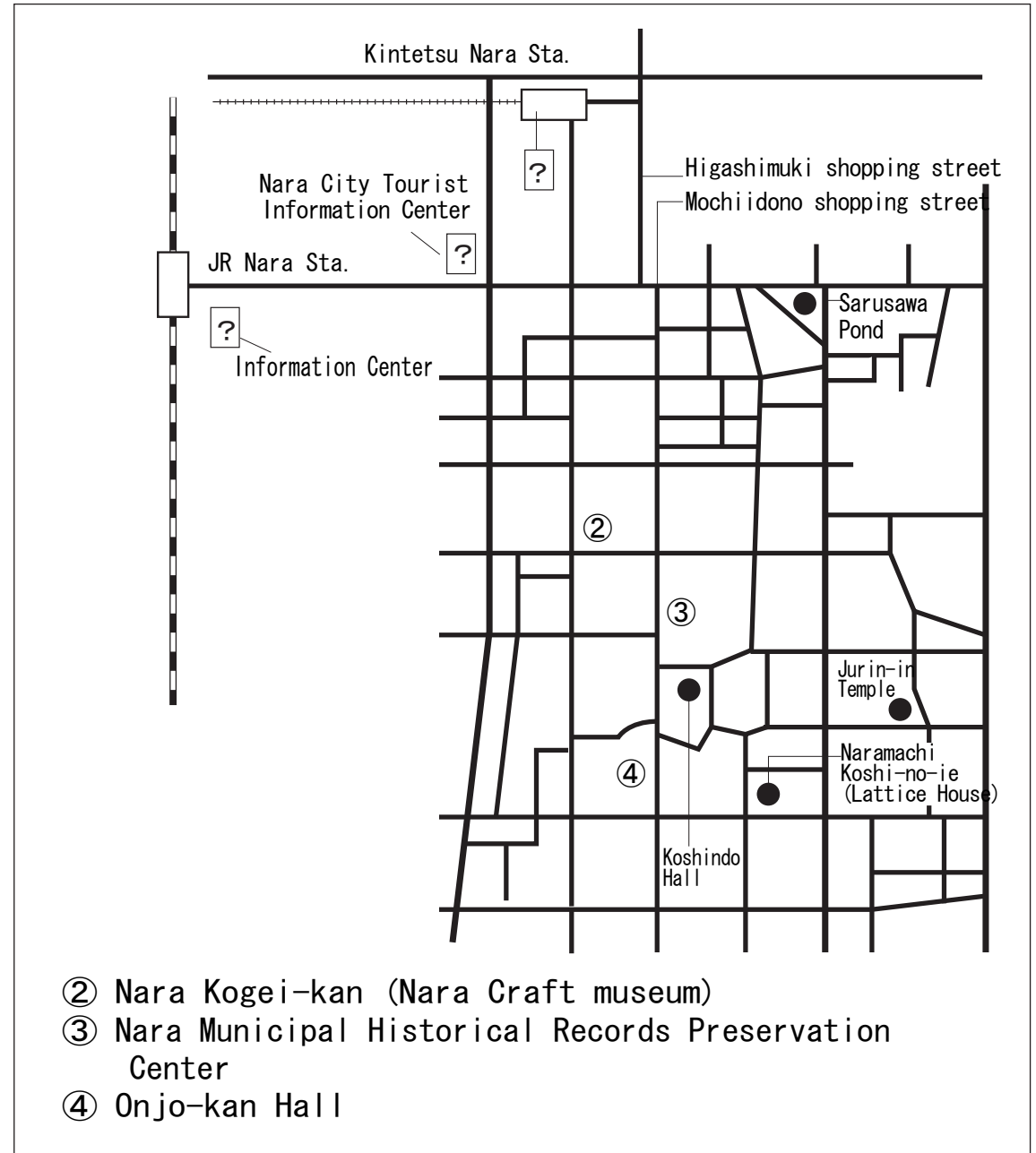
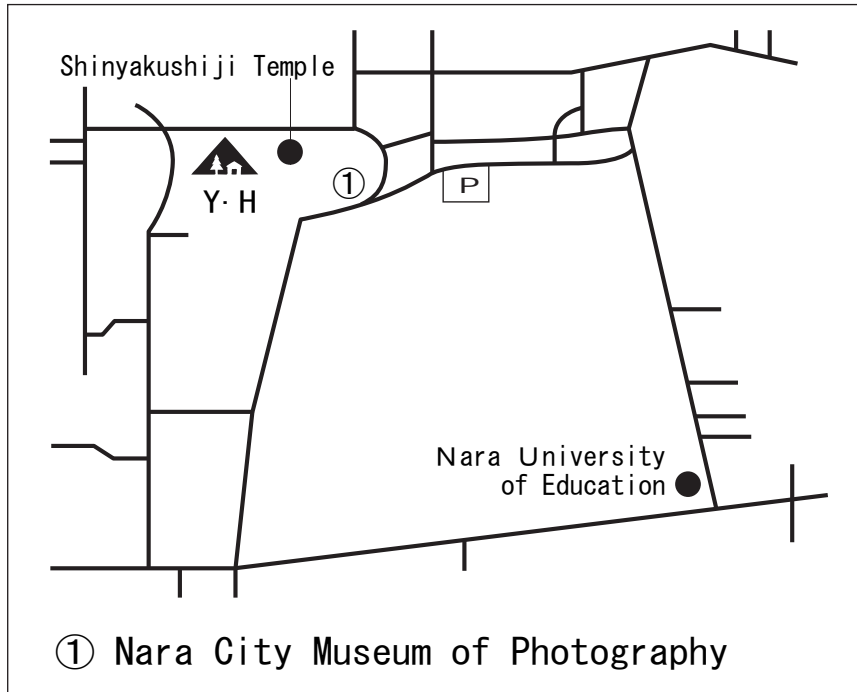

## – Courses for Wheel Chairs II (about 2 hours)

[All the facilities below are wheelchair accessible.]

### (1) Nara City Museum of Photography Course

[Access]by care-taxi from Kintetsu Nara Station to the Museum.

#### ①Nara City Museum of Photography [500 yen]

Exhibits photographs relating to Nara, especially masterpieces of the Late Taikichi Irie, a famous local photographer. This is a barrier-free facility for wheelchairs with wheelchair-accessible restrooms. Here you can enjoy a tranquil atmosphere amidst pastoral surroundings a little different to that of Nara Park.

### (2) Nara-machi Course

[Access]on foot from Kintetsu Nara Station

#### ②Nara Crafts Museum (Nara Kogei Kan) [No charge]

Exhibiting Nara crafts of the highest grade from various fields. This is a barrier-free facility with wheelchair-accessible restrooms.

#### ③Nara Municipal Historical Records Preservation Center [No charge]

Exhibits preserved historical records of Nara City. This is a barrier-free facility. Stroll around and enjoy the sights for as long as your time permits. There are various museums, restaurants, coffee shops and Nara's specialty linen-goods shops. Be careful of cars in the narrow street areas.

④Onjo-kan Hall [No charge] This is a good place to take a rest when you are tired. Wheelchair-accessible restrooms are available.
