Restorations and Exhibition Wing

- ◆ Year-round public viewing and explanations provided on restoration works in four areas (Buddhist sculptures, paintings, writings, historical buildings, archaeological discoveries)
- ◆ In addition to the valuable cultural assets of Nara, the center will also exhibit replicas of Buddhist images as well as excavated finds, all of which can be touched

Culture Exchange Wing

- ◆ A restaurant serving dishes made with local ingredients that also offers panoramic views of the Yamato Plains
- ◆ A shop with Nara's agricultural products and traditional crafts
- ◆ Cooking classes using the seasonal ingredients of Nara and traditional craftwork experiences

Artistic Culture Wing

- ◆ Public viewing and exhibition of works by Japanese and international artists
- ◆ Events such as traditional arts and cultural seminars
- ◆ Casual art sessions for everyone, including infants

Information Wing

- ◆ This facility will provide information about the historical and cultural resources, and tourism in the entirety of Nara Prefecture, as well as the surrounding areas

Outdoor Experience Zone

- ◆ The observatory deck and trails will offer beautiful views of the Yamato Plains and mountains

For the first time in Japan, the process of restoration from four different areas will be shown all year round to the public. Explanations will be given on the rarely seen techniques used during the restoration process, and the significance of continuous preservation.

(Restoration plans, photographs, films, etc.)

The Nara Prefecture Historical and Artistic Culture Complex will engage in training restorers to solve the shortages of leaders for carrying on preserving cultural legacies posed by the declining birth rate, ageing of society, and depopulation.

◆ Lectures and training seminars for gaining practical skills will be given by experienced and professional lecturers on construction carpentry, plastering, and roof tile-making.

◆ Training courses regarding the latest knowledge and techniques in preservation and restoration will be given by guest lecturers from overseas.

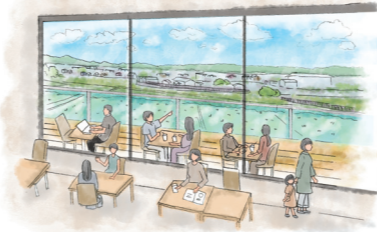
