



- [1] This year, Tokyo will be an exciting place in the world. The Paralympic Games will be held in Tokyo. During the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games, more than 4,000 athletes with disabilities will come to Tokyo and take part in the games from all over the world. The Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games will be the 16th summer Paralympic Games, and twenty-two kinds of sports will be carried out.
- One of the popular sports in the Paralympic Games is blind soccer. Blind soccer was played in the Paralympic Games in 2004 for the first time. Japanese blind soccer teams have never taken part in the Paralympic Games before, but the Japanese team will play in the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games. There are special rules in blind soccer. Blind soccer is played with four field players and one goalkeeper. The field players are blind, and they must wear special masks that cover their eyes. So they cannot see anything during the games. Only the goalkeeper doesn't have to wear a mask, and the goalkeeper can see everything on the field. When the players approach the opponent who has the ball, they must keep saying the Spanish word "voy" to the opponent. In blind soccer, the word means "I am approaching."
- [3] How can they play soccer without seeing anything? The ball in blind soccer makes sounds when it is moved on the field. The players listen to the sounds from the ball, and they know where the ball is. The sounds from the ball and the voices from the other players or team members have great importance in blind soccer. By listening to many kinds of sounds, the players know what is happening on the field. The people watching the games in the stadium should be quiet during the games. However, they can make sounds when the players score. With their voices, the players know that they have scored. The people watching the games can support the players with their voices and enjoy the games together with the players. The encouragement from the people who watch the games is a part of the blind soccer games.
- [4] The Paralympic Games are not just sports events for people with disabilities. They are great chances to think about a better society for all people around the world. In the Paralympic Games, athletes with disabilities try to do their best in each sport, and many people watch. The athletes in the Paralympic Games have made many world records these days. This is because they have improved their skills in each sport and have made their bodies strong. Improving the equipment of each sport is also one of the reasons for the new records. However, the true power of making many world records in the Paralympic Games comes from the challenge of doing these sports with a lot of encouragement.
