

Takeshi is a high school student. He studied in the US for one year. He came back to Japan one month ago, and he wrote about his experiences in the US in the school newspaper.

I studied in California. Why did I decide to study abroad? I wanted to communicate with a lot of people in other countries and expand my way of thinking. I learned a lot through my experiences in the US. So, I want to share some of them with you.

From Japan to California, it took about ten hours. My host family met me at the airport. After that, we had dinner together at a restaurant. It was a delicious dish, but it was karai for me, and I could not stop sweating. At that time, I did not know the English word for karai, so I could not explain my situation well to my host family. My host mother said, "Your face is bright red, and you're sweating a lot. You must be tired." I made my host mother very worried.

A few months later, I talked about it with my host family, and we laughed together. My host mother taught me that I could use gestures. Now, I know the word hot, and I can explain the situation. It was a good experience, and I learned that gestures help us communicate even if we cannot speak English well. It is one of my good memories.

I had another experience. On the second day of my stay in the US, we talked about ourselves and the house rules. My host family asked me questions about myself and my school life in Japan. I understood their questions, but I could not answer them well because I was afraid of making mistakes.

One day, my host mother said to me, "The English in the letter I received in advance was perfect, so I thought you could communicate in English without any problems." Before leaving Japan, I wrote a letter to my host family. I wrote it by using only the phrases in reference materials. My host mother continued, "Now, you can communicate well in English." We laughed together on that day, too. It is also one of my good memories. I think it is important to try to communicate without being afraid of making mistakes.

These are just two of my many experiences in the US, and these are not happy experiences. However, I can tell you that we can learn a lot from any kind of experiences.
