What is the Mahoroba Pass?

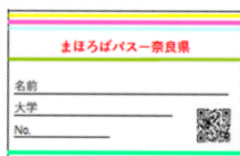

Application

There are 2 ways to apply.

- ① Bring your student ID or something that identifies you as a student to the International Exchange Saloon.
- ② Go to your school's student support center and ask about applying.

You use the pass by showing it, **with your student ID** at the reception desk at your destination.

- Only you are allowed to use the pass, so do not lend it to a friend.

- The time and season you can use the pass changes depending on destination.
- The pass is valid until the validity period. After this period, you will need to apply for a new one.
- You cannot use the pass at Toudaiji-temple.
