

How to call the police and dialogue model

In case of a traffic accident, burglary or being victim of violence, call the police. The phone number is “110” and is free, even when calling from public phones. Once an officer gets your call, tell him/her the following.

1. I don't speak much Japanese.

2. Why you are calling?

-Traffic accident.

KOUTSU JIKO DESU.

-Burglar.

DOROBOU DESU.

-Be subject to violence.

BOURYOKU O UKEMASHITA.

-Please come right away.

SUGUNI KITE KUDASAI.
